# Important Update: Implementation Timeline Update for Awards and Recognition Program Changes

After extensive feedback from FFA stakeholders, we have decided to delay the implementation of the recently announced changes to the 2025 Awards and Recognition Programs. This decision will ensure that everyone has adequate time to prepare and transition smoothly, without disrupting the ongoing 2024 SAE programs, which could have been negatively impacted by mid-course application changes.

Key Updates and Reasons for Delay:

- 1. Adequate Preparation Time: Our members, advisors, and state leaders require more time to understand and implement the changes effectively.
- 2. Consistency for Current Programs: We want to ensure that ongoing SAE work can be submitted using the same applications, maintaining fairness for all students and advisors involved.
- 3. State Association Needs: State associations need additional time to communicate and integrate these

changes before the new school year begins.

#### Looking Ahead to 2027:

In 2027, we will implement a more comprehensive update to the SAE-Based Awards Program to align with the "SAE for All" initiative. This includes:

- Creating School-Based Enterprise and Service-Learning categories.
- Potential updates to Placement/Internship, Ownership/Entrepreneurship and Research.
- Potential updates to degree requirements and CDE and LDE formats.

#### **Timeline for Future Changes:**

- **January 2025:** Announce minor updates for 2026 and release the 2026 handbooks. Major changes for 2027 will be announced with corresponding materials.
- **Throughout 2025-2026:** State Associations will receive complete 2027 update information to allow enough time to prepare for the transition.

This phased communication and implementation plan ensures ample preparation time for all parties, aiming for a seamless transition to the updated awards structure by 2027.

Students will select the pathway in which their research impacts.

Students will select five different AFNR indicators from their Primary Pathway. Students will need to articulate why their skills align with the indicator selected.

# **National Chapter Award Program**

## **Application Update**

Minor application updates will take place to accommodate any needed changes to the online/electronic submission of agriscience fair applications for national competition.

#### Reminders:

- The handbook and rubrics are updated annually. The updated handbook and rubrics will be published in September 2024.
- The next revision of the National Chapter Award Program will be after the National Council for Agricultural Education updates the National Quality Program Standards (NQPS). Depending on when the Council releases the updated NQPS, there may be a one-cycle delay in updating the application, as updates will not be made mid-award cycle.

### American FFA Degree

No significant changes are planned to the American FFA Degree application for the 2025 award year.

Detailed State approval and national submission deadlines continue to be as follows:

- March 15 Applications submitted by this date are guaranteed a two-week revision opportunity if required.
- April 15 Applications submitted by this date should have a two-week revision opportunity if required, but not guaranteed.
- May 15 Applications submitted by this day may have a one-week or less revision opportunity, which is not guaranteed.
- **June 15** Final Submission Deadline Applications submitted in June will have no revision opportunity and will be rejected should the national review find any issues.
